RESOLUTION NAMING A STUDY ROOM AT THE FORSYTH COUNTY CENTRAL LIBRARY IN MEMORY OF DR. SAMUEL CLAY WILLIAMS AND WIFE, MARY BASHER WILLIAMS IN RECOGNITION OF THEIR FAMILY'S DONATION

WHEREAS, Dr. Samuel Clay Williams, Jr. was born September 27, 1920 and after graduating from Princeton in 1942, and University of Pennsylvania Medical School in 1945, Dr. Williams served two years in the U.S. Navy; and

WHEREAS, Mary Basher Williams was born April 8, 1924, and after graduating from the University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing in 1946, she was a pediatric ward supervisor at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, while on fellowship at University of Pennsylvania, Dr. Williams met Mary Basher and they married in 1951; and

WHEREAS, the couple settled in Winston-Salem where Dr. Williams practiced internal medicine in private practice and at Forsyth Memorial Hospital until his retirement in 1985; and

WHEREAS, Mary Williams devoted 63 years to community service and faithful membership at First Presbyterian Church, served on the boards of Winston-Salem Symphony, N.C. School of Arts, Junior League, Red Cross, Forsyth Medical Auxiliary, Summit School Council, and Children's Center; Mary Williams also acted in Little Theater, hosted WSJS story hour, served as TV-Radio Council President in 1960 and owned the Village Book Shop for 33 years; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Williams continued to be active during retirement by volunteering with Senior Services and visiting former patients to offer support, a faithful member of First Presbyterian Church, serving many years as Elder, and he was a member of the Downtown Rotary and served on the boards of Salem College, Davidson College, NCNB, and N.C. Stroke Association; and

WHEREAS, both Dr. Williams and his wife, Mary shared a love of books and their three children have donated \$10,000 in memory of their parents to support the Central Library renovation/reconstruction project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby thanks the family of Dr. Samuel Clay Williams and Mary B. Williams for their memorial donation in the amount of \$10,000 toward the Forsyth County Central Library renovation/reconstruction project.
